At the outset, Dr. Rakesh Kumar, Member Secretary welcomed the Hon'ble Chairman and other members to the 5<sup>th</sup> meeting of Academic Council of the Institute. Thereafter, with the permission of the Hon'ble Chairman, the agenda items were deliberated upon and the following decisions were taken unanimously:

Item No. 5.1 Decision: Confirmation of the proceedings of 4<sup>th</sup> meeting of Academic Council
The proceedings of the 4<sup>th</sup> meetings of Academic Council were
confirmed as no comments have been received from any member of
Academic Council.

Item No. 5.2 To report action taken on the decisions of the 4th meeting of the Academic Council

Decision:

The action taken report was approved by Academic Council with the following amendments:

Item no. 4.9 'Approval of Academic Regulations 2015-16' was deliberated and following modifications was unanimously accepted:

- (1) The condition of minimum 75% attendance in all theory and practical courses will include maximum relaxation of 10% for all kinds of leaves (e.g. on medical ground, for appearing in competitive exams, etc. etc.), However, while awarding marks for attendance, only the actual percentage of attendance must be considered. The maximum relaxation of 10% in attendance is only for clearing the condition of minimum attendance.
- (2) "6-months training" that was renamed as "Semester Training" will have two components:

Component-1: Three months Industrial Training. It will be conducted in Industry.

Component-2: Two months software Training. For this component the student will have the option to undergo it at the Institute or at the Industry. However, the institute will preferably accommodate most of the students at the institute itself.

(3) Following marks distribution is adopted for the two components of training replacing the earlier proposed plan:

For Component-1: 3-months Industrial Training

- (4) If a student fails in a course, he can either repeat the whole course or can pass that course by re-appearing in the End-Term Examinations.
- The CGPA multiplication factor will be 10.

- (1) As far as possible, the chairman of the UMC committee must be preferred to be a retired judge.

#### Remuneration for the Members of UMC committee Item No. 5.4 Decision:

The item was approved as proposed with the following additions:

- (1)TA/DA to outside members will be paid as per MRSSTU rules.
- (2) No remuneration and TA/DA will be paid to the Invited Subject Experts as they are the internal faculty of the institute. However, if internal faculty is on official duty outside the institute, then he/she will be paid TA/DA as per MRSSTU rules.
