Item No.6.04: Ratification of various expenditures after due approval from Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of the University

i) Ratification of advertisement for admission on Social Media

An approval was given by Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of SBSSU, Ferozepur vide dated 18.7.2023 for advertisement for admission on social Media subject to ratification of BOG.

As per policy, Directorate of Information and Public Rations(DPR), Punjab is the competent authority for the paid advertisement campaigns through social Media (website) i.e. Google, Face book, YouTube etc., and Request by the Head of department (University) should be sent to Administrative Secretary of IPR department along with the media plan. In case any special film production for advertisement is required, request can be made to Administrative Secretary of IPR department.

Considering the time constraint for admission, committee was recommended/given the opinion that, a special onetime permission may be taken from Hon'ble Vice Chancellor or Board of Governors to put up direct advertisement on social media up to Rs. 50,000/- (Fifty thousand only). Accordingly, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor has given approval dated 18.7.2023, subject to ratification (Annexure-E Page-15).

The matter is placed before Finance Committee for ratification please.

ii) Ratification of the fee of Income tax advocate.

Sh. Rajiv Sharma, Advocate, submitted a bill of Rs. 30,000/- on 04.10.2023for professional services rendered in relation to scrutiny assessment proceedings under the Income Tax Act, 1961 for the financial year 2014-15(Assessment Year 2015-16).

In the 20th meeting of the Finance Committee, a structured fee enhancement for various categories of advocates for judicial work was approved. The details are as follows:

- a) For Punjab & Darryana High Court, advocates Rs.15500/-
- b) For Distt. Courts Advocates Rs.5500/-
- c) For Labour Court Advocates Rs.2000/-
- d) Rs.250/- per case for legal advice.

In cases that happen to be connected, an addition fee of Rs.500/- will be paid per case.

A Case under section 147 was opened against the university by the income-tax department for the year 2014-15 Assessment Year 2015-16. This case was pursued by Sh. Rajiv Sharma, Advocate in favour of the university. The current structured fees do not specify charges for income tax-related advocacy. The unique nature and complexity of the income tax case handled by Sh. Rajiv Sharma compares with the claimed fee as per the established rates for judicial work. Considering these factors, Competent Authority approved the payment of Rs. 30,000/- as a special case vide noting dated05.01.2024 subject to ratification of Finance Committee.

The matter is placed before the Finance Committee for ratification please. (Annexure-F Page-16).

iii) To ratify the amount paid for soil filling in low-land area near university library (F block).

The work of soil filling in lowland area near University Library (Block F) was allotted to Provincial division, PWD (B&R), Ferozepur by Shaheed Bhagat Singh State University, Ferozepur. The Provincial division, PWD (B&R), Ferozepur estimated the cost for soil filling the lowland area at Rs. 19.52 lac. This estimate was thoroughly reviewed and subsequently approved by the competent authority vide letter no. 1872 dated 10/7/23 and 1765 dated24/7/23 (Copy attached). The Provincial division, PWD (B&R), Ferozepur demanded for 25% of the total amount to start the soil filling work vide letter no. 3009 dated 18/9/23 (2 pages). In accordance with the same, 25% of the total amount which amounts to Rs. 4.88 lac, was paid to the Provincial division, PWD (B&R), Ferozepur after approval from Vice-Chancellor vide letter no. 3113 dated 26/9/23 (2 pages) (Copy attached) to start the work of soil filling (Annexure-G Page-17–23).

The matter is placed before the Finance Committee for ratification please.

iv) Ratification of payments

The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor has approved several essential expenses of the University, such as electricity bills, government taxes, pending salaries, etc., for three months as per the approved budget for the financial year 2023-24 payable in 2024-25 or subject to approval of budget in upcoming Finance Committee Meeting for the financial year 2024-25, vide dated 10.04.2024. Furthermore, he

has extended this approval for an additional month, until July 2024, vide dated 04.07.24. During the financial year 2024-25 (April 2024 to July 2024), various essential expenses of the University have been paid as per the approved budget. Despite the above, retirement benefits such as leave encashment and gratuity were also disbursed to retired staff, subject to the ratification in the Finance Committee meeting (Annexure-H Page-24-26).

Item no 6.08 Approval for Not Refunding the Security Amount of a Student who has taken benefit of Student Exigency Fund.

As per the Institute Bye Laws section 22.4, a student can claim refund of the security after completion of his Programme of study. The application of the claim of the security by the student shall be given within one year (two semesters) from the completion date of his/her Programme of study along with no due certificate from Librarian, Hostel Mess and Accounts.

Further, in case of the death of a bread earner of the student during the course of the study, he/she can also apply to the University under "STUDENT EXIGENCY FUND" where his/her entire fee of remaining period of the study will be waived off by the University. Every student admitted to university contributes some fixed amount towards this fund along with his/her semester fee on non-refundable basis. In light of the above, it is proposed that if a student has taken the benefit of Student Exigency Fund from the University then his/her security may not be refunded as the University has already helped him by paying his/her entire fee for the remaining period of study.

The matter is placed before the Finance Committee for consideration and Approval please.

Item no. 6.09 Ratification for increase in the salaries of Assistant Professors/Lecturers appointed on a purely temporary, stop-gap basis.

A meeting of the Dean Academics and Heads of Departments (HoDs) was held on 02-02-2024 (**Annexure-L, Page No.43-45**) under the chairmanship of the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor. The following decision was taken:

"The challenge of recruiting and retaining quality faculty on an hourly basis, compounded by the inadequacy of the current salary structure, was deliberated upon by the HoDs. This matter had previously been addressed during the third Board of Governors (BoG) Meeting held on February 17, 2023 (vide Item No. 03.29), where it was resolved to form a committee chaired by the Hon'ble Administrative Secretary to the Government of Punjab, Department of Technical Education & Industrial Training, and the Registrar, SBSSU, Ferozepur. Although the committee report is yet to be presented at the upcoming BoG meeting, it was subsequently proposed during the meeting to elevate the maximum salary for faculty from Rs. 15,000 to Rs. 30,000 per month. The Vice Chancellor instructed the consolidation of the case for salary enhancement into a single file for approval from the Hon'ble Chairman of the Board of Governors."

It is hereby mentioned that on 09-02-2024, the Dean Academics reported as follows (Annexure M, Page No. 46):

"In the meetings of HoDs, the issue was raised by the heads of various departments regarding the challenge of recruiting and retaining quality faculty on an adhoc/hourly basis, compounded by the inadequacy of the current salary structure. Therefore, it is being proposed to elevate the maximum monthly emoluments of adhoc/lecture-based faculty hired on a temporary basis by various departments from Rs. 15,000 per month to Rs. 30,000 per month in order to attract and retain quality faculty as per the requirements in various departments of the university. The rate of emoluments per hour for faculty hired to work on an hourly basis may be revised proportionately, subject to a maximum of Rs. 30,000 per month."

Based on the above facts, the complete case was put up to the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor on 14-03-2024 for increasing the salary as per SBSSU, Gurdaspur

subject to approval from Hon'ble Technical Education Minister cum Chairman BOG and Ratification in the next BoG/Finance Committee Meeting. The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor recommended and forwarded it to the Hon'ble Technical Education Minister cum Chairman, BoG, SBSSU Ferozepur, on 31-07-2024 (Annexure K, Page No. 45) with the following comments:

"Faculty hired on a guest faculty basis at Ferozepur are paid Rs. 375/- per hour and Rs. 165/- per lab hour, whereas the same faculty is paid Rs. 1,000/- per hour at IKGPTU and Rs. 750/- per hour at SBSSU Gurdaspur. Kindly allow payment as per SBSSU Gurdaspur rates."

The approval from the Hon'ble Technical Education Minister cum Chairman, BoG, SBSSU Ferozepur, was received by the university vide Diary No. 9259, dated 06-08-2024 (Annexure K, Page No. 45).
