Item No. 9.3: Progress report of the College

Decision: The Board appreciated the record progress made by the college during the last 2 years and it's up gradation to the level of Technical Campus. Additionally, the following decisions

were taken:-

(1) The Board has sanctioned two more posts for sports department in order to create interest of students in sports and games, and to keep them physically fit i.e. one post of Coach for games and one post of Instructor for college Gymanisium/Health Club.

- (2) The Board has decided that more trees should be planted in the campus especially of Peepal, Bohar, Neem, Arjun and others shaded trees.
- (3) The Board has directed the Director to expedite the process of conversion and renovation of Chairman's office and Conference room. Further, it was decided to change the non-performing members of the existing committee constituted for this purpose as there is an inordinate delay by the committee in making the office of Chairman and conference room.
- (4) The Board has further decided to cover the internal opening areas of the Polytechnic buildings (Block-D) with sheets so that students can use this space for various curricular and extra-curricular activities.
- (5) The Board asked the Director to prepare the placement record of all those candidates who were trained under SDI scheme.

Action:

- (1) The post of Health Club attendant/helper was being filled-up.
- (2) About 500 shaded trees of Peepal, Bohar, Neem, Arjun etc were planted.
- (3) Dr. Kulbhushan Agnihotri, the non-performer member of Committee was changed with Mr. Inderpal Singh, Registrar to expedite the work of renovation of the office of Chairman and Conference room. The office of Hon'ble Chairman BOG has been renovated and Hon'ble Chairman BOG has already conducted 03 meetings in the said office. Further, the conference room has also been renovated and tender for procurement of furniture is in process.
- (4) Tender has been published to cover the internal opening areas of the Polytechnic buildings (Block-D) with sheets so that students can use this space for various activites.
- (5) The Training and Placement Officer is preparing the record of all those candidates who were trained under SDI scheme.

Item No. 9.4 Release of funds for construction of essential infrastructure at SBSSTC, Ferozepur

Decision: The Board has decided to recommends to the Government of Punjab, Department of Technical Education to release Rs. 12.90 Crore for the construction of essential

infrastructure in the college as proposed in this item.

Action: The proposal has already been sent to Govt of Punjab vide letter No. 4629-31 dated: 16-

10-2012 for getting Rs. 12.90 Crore for the construction of essential infrastructure in the campus.

The Hon'ble Chairman BOG has also written a DO Letter No. No.SBS/CHBG/2012/23 dated 30-10-2012 to Hon'ble Technical Education Minister of Punjab for getting Rs. 12.90 Crore for the construction of essential infrastructure in the campus.

Item No. 9.5 Grant of Rs 10.00 Crore from PTU for Construction of Hostels in the College Campus

Decision: The Board has approved the proposal and decided to request the Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar, to give Rs. 10 Crore as a grant to Shaheed Bhagat Singh State Technical Campus, Ferozepur for constructing a Boys Hostel as the present hostel

The Director has informed to the Board that this item has already been approved in the 11th meeting of the Building & Works Committee and 24th meeting of the Finance Committee of the college. The Vice Chancellor of Punjab Technical University, Sh. Item No. 9.6 Release of funds for construction of 3rd & 4th floors in the polytechnic & School Buildings at SBSSTC, Ferozepur

Decision: The Board has decided to recommend to the Government of Punjab, Department of

Technical Education to release funds of Rs 731.54 lakh under NABARD Scheme for completion of remaining two floors of the Polytechnic and School building so that these

buildings can be completed and fully utilized for the benefit of the students

ITEM NO. 10.3 Progress report of the College

The brief report on developments of College and various works/projects that have been completed/undertaken after the 9th meeting of BOG held on 22.09.2012 is given below:

- 1. The Institute has started the process of construction of 16 more Lecture halls/Tutorial halls as per the approval given in the 25th Finance Committee Meeting and 12th Building and works Committee held on 26.10.2012. The 8 lecture halls/tutorial halls are near completion.
- 2. The Construction work of new girls' hostel has started and likely to be completed within six months.
- 3. On the directions of Chairman BOG, the institute has procured internet Firewall from Nebero @ the cost of Rs. 1.25 Lakhs and Del Server @ cost of Rs. 1.80 Lakhs. With the intervention the Hon'ble Chairman BOG, the Institute could saved an amount of Rs. 94375/-.
- 4. ERP solution is in the advance stage of procurement for taking effective and efficient decisions as well as providing timely informations to the students and their parents about their results, certificates etc. etc. With the kind interventions of Hon'ble chairman BOG, the TCS has reduced the rates from Rs. 60 per students to Rs. 29 per students per month. Their MRP rate was Rs. 75 per students per month, but they had offered ERP solution to the Institute @ Rs. 60 per student per month.
- NBA accreditation work will be completed by 31 December 2012 and information will be uploaded as and when NBA accreditation portal will be open.

- 7. Two professional agencies SKIDT, Amritsar and TRINITi, Chandigarh were engaged to train the final year students to polish their professional skills & to prepare them for the upcoming placement drives. They have trained the students about two months for 40 hours each. SBS STC is the first Govt. managed Engg college to take initiative to start such extra classes by hiring specialized professional agencies as such professional skills are essential for the selection of students in various MNC's along with technical skills.
- 8. Sh. Surjit Kumar Jiani ji, Hon'ble Forest and Labour Minister Punjab and Sh. Sher Singh Gubhaiya, Hon'ble Member of Parliament have given a grant of Rs. 5.00 Lakhs each (Total Rs. 10.00 Lakhs) for developing Gymnasium in the Campus.
- 9. Eight smart class rooms are being developed and CCTV cameras are being installed in all lecture halls of the campus.
- 10. The College website has been upgraded and all emails of faculty and students are being made on one domain.
- 11. All complaints of houses, hostels and teaching blocks related to civil, electrical maintenance etc etc are made online.
- 12. Wearing of uniform dress code by faculty, non-teaching staff, Gardeners, Sweepers and Security Guards is made mandatory on one day in a week. Similarly all students are directed to wear uniform dress on one day in a week. Further it is made mandatory that all students, staff and faculty should wear dress during campus

- 13. Placement and other important occasions of the college like convocation, annual function, sports meet etc.
- 14. The 2nd Convocation, 2nd Alumni Meet and Techno-Festival have been scheduled on 13-15 Feb. 2012.
- 15. The Institute has applied to AICTE New Delhi for increasing the 30 seats of Electronics and Communication Engineering and 60 seats of Civil Engineering disciplines.
- 16. Companies like INFOSYS; Pro India Group, Noida; Absolute Sports Pvt. Ltd.; Piford Technologies; Betasoft and Unit Nexus have visited the campus for placement after September 2012and about 55 students were placed in these companies and various companies like Enbake Consulting, Escorts Faridabad (Nuts & Bolts Division), Escorts Faridabad (Tractor Division), Grundfos-Chennai, Nestle India Ltd., MAX India Ltd., Sonalika Tractors, Vibe Tech Solutions etc have scheduled their visit for campus placement in the month of Jan-Feb 2013.
- 17. Planted about 500 shaded trees in the campus.
- 18. Opened Verka booth in the campus.
- 19. Annual athletic meet will be held in the month of Feb/March 2013.
- 20. The Institute has given scholarships to the economically weaker students at the Institute level as per following details:

Item No. 10.4 To Approve the Procurement plan of TEQIP- II Project of MHRD

The Institute has got a TEQIP Project, Phase II, subcomponent 1.1 (Strengthening Institutions to Improve learning Outcomes and Employability of Graduates) of MHRD, Govt. of India through Punjab Govt.

Under this project, the Institute has got a grant of Rs. 10 Crores which is to be spent as per MHRD and Punjab Govt guidelines. This grant will be spent (Head Wise) as per the detail given at **Annexure – III on page no. 32.** First Installment of Rs Two Crores has already been credited into accounts of the Institute.

The Procurement plan prepared by the TEQIP Project Implementation Committee has already been approved by the NPIU, new Delhi. Subsequently, due to non receipt of grant, it was again uploaded to revise the procurement schedule which was already approved by NPIU. The approved procurement plan is placed as **Annexure-III Page No 33—37.**

Further, Dr. Satvir Singh, Nodal Officer Procurement of TEQIP Project, has attended the seminar organized by NPIU on 24-25 Dec. 2012. Dr Satvir Singh told that in the said seminar, NPIU experts have advised to all colleges to get their Procurement Plan approved by BOG before affecting any purchase.

Further, as per the direction of Hon'ble Chairman BOG, the Procurement plan has again been revised o distribute the grant equally among all the departments and to procure the equipments which are more inclined to the requirement of undergraduate students. The revised Procurement Plan is placed at **Annexure-III on page no. 38-40**.

The Procurement plan placed at **Annexure-III on page no. 38-40** is put before the Board for consideration and approval please.

Item No. 10.5 Approval to Procure ERP solution from TCS

SBS State Technical campus is expanding in all dimensions. To come at par with expectations of its recipients and compete with time, it has now become essential to look forward for automation of records of various departments and sections.

Keeping this in view, a committee was constituted to suggest the solution for automation of records of various departments and sections which shall help in taking effective and efficient decisions as well as providing timely informations to the students and their parents about their results, certificates etc. etc.

The Committee has reported that during presentation the TCS has reduced the rates of ERP solution from Rs. 75 per students per month to Rs. 60 being educational institute discount. The Committee further reported that with the intervention and negotiation by the hon'ble Chairman BOG, company has now submitted the proposal @ Rs. 29/per user per month for minimum 3500 users i.e. Rs. 1,01,500 per month exclusive of any taxes. The details of cost and other terms and conditions of TCS are given at page no. 14 of TCS proposal attached as **Annexure-IV at page no. 60.**

The committee has recommended to procure ERP solution from Tata Consultancy Services (TCS) as a proprietary item which provides Cloud based ERP solution for institutes named iON. Accordingly, purchase section sought approval to place the order to TCS for ERP solution. The report of the purchase section and purchase committee is placed as Annexure-IV at Page No. 41-80.

The matter is placed before BOG for consideration and approval to procure the ERP Solution from TCS @ Rs. 1,01,500 per month exclusive of taxes and duties on the terms and conditions mentioned at page no. 14 of TCS Proposal (Annexure-IV, Page No. 60).

Item No. 10.6 Approval to issue Appointment letters to Teaching Faculty

An agenda item to recruit faculty at Institute level was put up in the 25th meeting of Finance Committee vide item no. 25.15. Keeping in view the urgent faculty requirement in Electrical and Civil Engineering Departments, it was decided to recruit 02 Assistant Professors each in Civil Engineering and Electrical Engineering department (01 on regular basis and 01 on Contract basis) respectively at the Institute level for the time being, till the review of decision of 3rd party hiring through NITTTR, Chandigarh is pending with the Punjab Govt. Further in the 25th F.C. Meeting, it was decided to issue NOC to Sh. Vikas Goyal Asstt. Prof (CSE) for permanent absorption/ deputation at MIMIT Malout and the Institute was allowed to recruit 01 Asstt. Prof. (CSE) at the Institute level on contract basis (Annexure-V on page no. 82-86).

Accordingly, with the approval of Hon'ble Chairman BOG vide file no. 25 dated 10-11-2012 an advertisement was floated in 03 leading newspapers to recruit the above faculty. Subsequently, approval was sought from the Hon'ble Chairman BOG vide file no. SBSCET/Fzr/5559 dated 06-12-2012 to recruit the Assistant Professors in Civil Engg, Electrical Engg. and Computer Science & Engg at College level as per college bye-laws; to approve the panel of experts and to call the shortlisted candidates for interview. The Chairman BOG has given the approval vide file No. 30 dated 7.12.2012. The complete record is placed as **Annexure-V on page no. 81-95.**

The interviews to select the above faculty were held in the Campus on 17& 18 December 2012. Since the Civil Engg department was having no faculty (either regular or contract), the Staff Selection Committee unanimously decided to select the 02 candidates on regular basis. Further, Electrical Engg. Deptt. was having one faculty on regular and one on contract basis, it was decided to select the 02 candidates on regular basis and 01 on contract basis subject to approval by Board of Governors. Besides this, 01 candidate was selected for Computer Sc. & Engg. Department on contract basis. All the above said selections are made against sanctioned posts. Minutes of the selection Committees are attached at **Annexure-V on page no. 96-98.**

In the light of above, BOG is requested to approve the selection of above said faculty and allow to issue the appointment letters to the selected candidates.

Item No. 10.7 Approval to issue Appointment letters to non-Teaching Staff

Services of a Clerk was required for the office of Hon'ble Chairman BOG, for which approval was given by Hon'ble Chairman BOG vide file no. 12 dated 31-08-2012, which was ratified in the 9th meeting of BOG vide agenda item no. 9.25. Besides this, to create interest among the students in sports and games, 01 post of Coach and 01 post of Instructor for the Institute Gymnasium / Health Club was sanctioned vide agenda item no. 9.3.

Accordingly, with the approval of Hon'ble Chairman BOG vide file no. 18 dated 06-10-2012 an advertisement were floated in 03 leading newspapers to recruit 01 Clerk and 01 Instructor-cum-Caretaker (Health Club).

Subsequently, approval was sought from the Hon'ble Chairman BOG vide file no. SBSCET/Fzr/5412 dated 29-11-2012 to recruit the Instructor-cum-caretaker and clerk at College level as per college bye-laws; to approve the panel of experts and to call the shortlisted candidates for interview. The Chairman BOG has given the approval vide file No. 28 dated 30.11.2012. The complete record is placed as **Annexure-VI on page no. 99-112.**

The scrutinizing Committee has given the opinion that the qualification for the advertised post of Instructor-cum-caretaker of Health Club is not of the level of Instructor. Therefore qualification of none of the candidates is suitable for the said post. The scrutinizing committee further suggested that it up to the selection committee to select any of them, whoever has applied, for any lower post i.e. attendant/helper. Accordingly all the candidates who have applied for the above post were called for interview on 17.12.2012. During interaction by the selection committee with the candidates only Sh. Mukesh Sachdeva has expressed his willingness to join at the lower post i.e. attendant / helper (health club). So the selection committee has recommended that he may be offered the post of attendant / helper (health club) for a period of one year on a consolidated salary of Rs. 10,000/per month. Minutes of the selection Committees are attached at Annexure-VI on page no. 113-114.

Further, an interview for the post of clerk was held on 17.12.2012 and Minutes of the selection Committees are attached at **Annexure-VI** on page no. 115.

In the light of above, BOG is requested to approve the selection of above said staff and allow to issue appointment letters to the selected candidates for the post of Clerk and attendant / helper of Health Club.

Item No. 10.8 Sanction of 03 posts of Clerks under TEQIP scheme of MHRDand filling of 02 posts of clerks from the panel of waiting list dated 17.12.2012

The TEQIP Project Implementation Committee has given the proposal to appoint TEQIP Project personals for providing assistance in implementing the TEQIP Project. The report of committee is placed as **Annexure-VII at page No.116-120.** As per the terms and conditions of TEQIP Project of MHRD, the Institute is required to put almost the entire academic, Stores, Inventory, Accounting and Establishment data into the ERP system so that decision making in the institute can be efficient & effective to compare the improvements and performance of the Institute over the years. Further, the data is required to be entered in various formats given by MHRD, Govt of Punjab from time to time.

The TEQIP Project implementation committee stated that as per the provisions of TEQIP Project of MHRD, the manpower can be hired over and above the sanctioned posts for implementing the Project smoothly. Therefore the committee has requested to hire the services of three persons proficient in computer data entry on contract basis from the Project grant.

Therefore 03 posts of clerks can be sanctioned by BOG on contract basis and the salaries of the persons recruited for theses three posts will be met from the funds of TEQIP project given by MHRD Govt of India Annexure-VII page No. 117-120.

It is also stated that the interview for recruitment of clerk in the Institute has already been conducted on 17/12/12 and minutes of the selection committee are placed at **Annexure-VI page no. 115.** It is proposed that two persons out of the waiting list of candidates may be considered for these posts of clerks to avoid reprocessing and delay.

The Matter is placed before the Board to sanction 03 posts of clerks from the funds of TEQIP project and approval may also be given to issue the appointment letters to 02 persons from the waiting list dated 17.12.2012 kept for the post of Clerk.

The matter is placed before BOG for consideration and approval.

Item No. 10.9 Approval to start second shift courses of PTU Jalandhar

A committee consisting of the following was constituted to review the financial position of SBSSTC Ferozepur viz-a-viz PTUGZS campus and to suggest new avenues of resource generations:

- (i) Dr. Buta Singh, Dean Academics, PTU Jalandhar
- (ii) Dr. Rakesh Kumar, Dean Academics, SBSSTC, Fzr
- (iii) Sh. Inderpal Singh, Registrar, SBSSTC, Ferozepur

The committee met on 20.10.2012 and has recommended to start the M.Tech regular & second shift of B.Tech under the PTU Regional Center. The committee has further recommended to utilize the 80% of resources so generated for the development of Infrastructure of the Institute and remaining 20% of surplus funds should be kept in the PTU account for meeting other expenses for a gestation period of ten years. The recommendation of the Committee are placed as **Annexure-II on Page no. 31.**

Further, it is proposed to start BSc Agriculture Engineering and B.Com classes with intake of 60 students each as Non-AICTE Courses and to discontinue of BSc (IT) course from the next academic session.

Submitted to BOG for consideration and approval:

Item No. 10.10 Revision of Recruitment Criteria for Teaching Posts

In this Campus recruitment of teaching staff is done on the basis of criteria provided by Punjab Govt., Department of Technical Education vide Endst.No.2/104/98(P.F)-5TE-II/1556-65 dated 29.03.2000. **Annexure-VIII on Page no. 121-128.** This criteria is quite old and does not meets the present requirements as per revised qualification & experience for the post of Assistant Professor and Associate Professor prescribed by the AICTE, New Delhi.

In addition to this, the candidates coming from Private Engineering Colleges/Institutes generally score more marks as compared to candidates of reputed/established Institutes such as Govt. Institutes / PEC Univ. / Thapar Univ. / GNDEC, Ludhiana etc. due to liberal attitude of Private College Authorities.

In the light of above, it is proposed that the criteria for recruitment of teaching faculty may be revised with the addition of written objective type test and total 50 marks meant for B.Tech and M.Tech. qualifications may be divided as below:

Objective type test: 30 marks M.Tech. qualification: 20 marks

The revised summary sheet for the post of Assistant Professor and Associate Professor is placed at **Annexure -VIII on page no. 129** [Note: the 10 marks kept for Ph.D (higher qualification) for the post of Assistant Prof. in the summary sheet shall be substituted for the supervision of minimum 03 completed M.Tech thesis/01 Ph.D. thesis for the post of Associate Professor].

The revised summary sheet for the post of Assistant Professor and Associate Professor is submitted for approval of the BOG please.

At the time of relieving, his complete case was sent to Punjab Govt. vide noting no. 8537 dated 19-10-2010. In response to this, Punjab Govt. vide memo no.2/63/2006-TE2/5241 dated 23-11-2010 issued instructions to the Institute to put up this case in the next BOG meeting. Since the next BOG meeting was not yet fixed and the 23rd Finance committee meeting was going to be held shortly under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Principal Secretary Technical Education & Industrial Training, Punjab, his case was put up in this meeting vide agenda item No.23.9. The decision of the said meeting is reproduced as under:

Thereafter detailed case vide noting no. 4989 dated 07-11-2012 was sent to Hon'ble Chairman BOG for consideration and further orders (**Annexure IX**, page No. 131-139). The Hon'ble Chairman vide file no.26 dated 15-11-2012 ordered to take legal opinion in this case (**Annexure-IX**, page no. 131-132). Accordingly, legal opinion was sought vide Institute letter no. [&]quot;The committee of observed that he is neither properly recruited nor does he fulfills the prescribed qualifications for the post of clerk. Therefore, committee expressed its inability to regularize his services."

Estb/SA-2/5463-67 dated 30-11-2012 **Annexure-IX on page no. 140.**

Thereafter, Sh. Raj Kumar has requested to appoint him as Clerk on regular basis and threatened the authorities that in case he goes into depression/any personal mishappening, the Director of the Institute will be solely responsible for this (**Annexure-IX**, **page no. 141**). Acting upon his threat, a complaint was filed with the SHO, Kulghari (Ferozepur) with a copy to Hon'ble Chairman BOG, PSTE/IT Punjab and SSP, Ferozepur for information and necessary action (**Annexure-IX**, **page no. 142**).

In the light of above, the orders of Punjab Govt. memo No. 2/63/2006-TE2/3482 dated 23-08-2012 (**Annexure-IX on page no. 130**) are placed before the BOG for consideration and appropriate decision please.

A detailed case of Mr. Raj Kumar was sent to Hon'ble Chairman BOG for consideration and further orders vide noting no. 4989 dated 07-11-2012. The Hon'ble Chairman vide file no.26 dated 15-11-2012 ordered to take legal opinion in this case (**Annexure- IX**, **page no. 131-139**). Accordingly, legal opinion was sought vide Institute letter no. SBS/FZR/E-2/5234-35 dated 16-11-2012 from the advocate Mr. Yogesh. The legal opinion given by advocate is placed as **Annexure-IX**, **Page No. 134**).

The legal opinion was put up to the Hon'ble Chairman BOG for further orders. Vide file no. 27 dated 16-11-2012, the Hon'ble Chairman BOG has given the orders which are reproduced as under:

"As per legal opinion of advocate Mr. Yogesh. Mr. Raj Kumar be appointed for 6 months on temporary basis on his present qualification as per the college bye-laws 2.11."

Since as per record the educational qualification of Sh. Raj Kumar is 10+2 and, therefore, according to his qualification and availability of vacancy in the Institute, he was offered the post of Workshop Attendant on purely temporary basis on contract for a period of six month in the pay scale Rs.5910-20200+GP1400 vide letter no. Estb/SA-2/5463-67 dated 30-11-2012 The complete case is placed as **Annexure- IX**, **page No. 131-142**). More detail is given at agenda item No.10.11

5. To ratify the extension of deputation of Mr. Harshwinder Singh, Steno-typist

The Chairman BOG has given the approval for the extension in deputation of Mr. Harshwinder Singh, Steno-typist for a period of 01 year (Annexure- XI, page No. 160-170).
